# TOM DWYER AUTOMOTIVE SERVICES WHEEL TORQUE POLICY (rev 2/1/18)

To all Tom Dwyer Automotive Services employees:

#### When removing and replacing wheels:

- All wheels will be properly hand-torqued to the vehicle's specifications.
- Tires will be <u>clearly</u> marked on the inboard sidewall <u>and</u> a small but visible dot adjacent to the valve stem on the outboard side of a torqued wheel, using a tire crayon of the currently assigned color.
- This policy is for all employees and will be followed without exception.

Failing to properly tighten a Customer's wheels can lead to a dangerous condition. This failure exposes the Company and all employees to liability, and places our clients' and other's lives and property at risk.

Releasing a vehicle with improperly torqued wheels may be grounds for Termination.

All damages and expenses will become the responsibility of the employee or employees determined to be at fault.

Regardless of tenure or position, the individual determined not to have followed Wheel Torque Policy, the action is as follows:

## 1. First incident may be grounds for Termination.

If not terminated, Written Warning with details of the event will be issued, signed and placed in the employee files.

#### 2. Second incident may be grounds for Termination.

If not terminated, Written Warning with details of the event will be issued, signed and placed in the employee files. Suspension without pay for one day minimum will be ordered.

### 3. Third incident will be grounds for Termination.
